TRANSPORTATION OPTIONS

DULLES INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

The Boar's Head Inn in Charlottesville is located 100 miles southwest of Dulles Airport, approximately a 2-hour drive.

Driving from Dulles

From the Dulles Airport Access Road, take the exit toward VA-28 S, followed by the ramp toward I-495/VA-28. Merge onto VA-28 S and stay on Route 28 for 8.5 miles. Then merge onto I-66 W toward Front Royal. After 10 miles, merge onto US-29 S via Exit 43A (Gainesville, Warrenton). Travel Route 29 South for 80 miles into Charlottesville. Exit onto the Route 250 West bypass (Lynchburg, Staunton, Richmond.) Follow the Route 250 bypass to the third exit, Route 250 W. At the traffic light, turn left onto Route 250 W and drive for one mile. Turn left onto Ednam Drive at the third stoplight. The entrance to the Boar's Head Inn will be on your left.

Train

From Dulles, take a 20-minute taxi to the Amtrak station at 9431 West Street in Manassas, Virginia. Amtrak's Cardinal and Crescent lines connect from the Manassas train station to Charlottesville. Trains leave the Manassas station once daily at 7:22pm. On Wednesdays, Fridays, and Sundays another train connects through Manassas at 12:02pm. The ticket cost is around \$20.

Trains also leave to Charlottesville from Union Station in downtown Washington, D.C. at 11:10am and 6:30pm daily. Tickets cost around \$30 each.

Bus

Take a Washington Flyer taxi or the Super Shuttle from Dulles Airport to the Greyhound Bus station located at 1005 1st Street, NE in downtown Washington, D.C. Buses leave to Charlottesville at 2:15am, 10:00am, 5:05pm, and 5:30pm. Prices range from \$12 to \$30. Buses arrive at the Greyhound station in downtown Charlottesville (310 West Main Street).

Local Transportation

If arriving by bus or train, taxis are available at the train and bus stations in downtown Charlottesville. The Boar's Head Inn is located at 200 Ednam Drive in Charlottesville, west of downtown.
