**TAIWAN FINANCIAL SERVICES SEMINAR TO FEATURE KEYNOTE SPEECH BY KONG JAW-SHENG,
CHAIRMAN OF TAIWAN'S FINANCIAL SUPERVISORY COMMISSION**

(June 14, 2005 – New York, NY) The Chairman of Taiwan's Financial Supervisory Commission (FSC), Kong Jaw-sheng, will give a luncheon keynote address entitled "A New Era of Financial Supervision in Taiwan" during the **Taiwan Financial Services: Trends, Outlook, and Opportunities** seminar in New York City on June 23, 2005. The FSC, established in 2004, is the cabinet-level regulator that supervises rule-setting for and monitoring of the banking, securities, futures, and insurance industries in Taiwan.

Prior to the luncheon keynote, seminar participants will also benefit from presentations and Q&A sessions on key issues in the Taiwan market, including the impact of new financial reforms, the growth in cross-Strait financial ties, incentives for M&A activity, the latest developments in the Equity, Bond, and Derivatives Markets, and future Taiwan market opportunities.
